

**TOWN OF COUNTY LINE**  
**Regular Meeting**  
**September 14, 2020**

**I. Call to order**

Mayor Arthur Self called to order the regular meeting of the Council at 7:00 pm on September 14, 2020 in the Town Hall. The invocation was given by Myrtle VanKleeck. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all.

**II. Roll call**

**III. Approval of Minutes and Financials**

1. Cobb Brazeel Road still needs work. Commissioner Washburn noted that some mow-trim work was done on it. He also said that they would work on the ditches when they come back to work on Smith Mill Rd.

2. The Clerk does have an Audit scheduled for September 28<sup>th</sup>.
3. No update on the ALAWEST vs. Mulvehill Lawsuit, but the Mayor did receive the Judge's Order dismissing the Town of County Line.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

1. There was discussion as to what we can do on Smith Mill Rd. Mayor Self suggested that Comm. Washburn and Councilman Brewer ride the road in order to make a plan for this work. Comm. Joe Knight agreed to check on some help from Jefferson County for the Smith Mill Road project.
2. We have an invoice from Blount County for Mow/trim work, payment on this will be put on HOLD at this time.
3. We received another request for a donation to the Blount County Animal Shelter. This will be paid based on a population number on 156 at \$2 per person, \$312.00.
4. Mayor Self showed his draft of the Budget for the year 2021.
5. Mayor Self also presented us with the Architect's new design for our County Line Safe Room building.

### **ORDINANCES**

1. There was a second reading of the proposed Mobile Home Ordinance. After much discussion, this was tabled for the next meeting.
