Turned in and clerk will give a receipt and check. Larry asked Pam to call clerk about receipt and checks. Bryan said caution light is dangerous and the pull out at road is also. He suggested to put up a mirror. Larry said the road may need to be fixed. Pam will get with Earl about who would fix the road, the town or County. Earl advised Pam we wouldn't have to pay for Smith Mill rd. He will get an audit for us about how much we have already paid. Pam said we need supplies for election, pen and etc.... Larry made the motion to let Pam buy supplies and Bryan 2<sup>nd</sup> - motion carried. Mellany made motion to adjourn and Bill 2<sup>nd</sup> - motion carried.
