Old Business

Council discussed the roof and decided to use treated wood if the total amount spent would not be more than the \$2,100.00 allotted for the roof.

The clause in the insurance policy mentioning the equipment is a standard clause and was not put in the policy for a particular reason.

The council decided to take out an ad in the Birmingham New and in the Blount County paper for sealed bids and adding a minimum bid, (\$2,000 for the police car). This should be posted on the door of the town hall and at Young's Grocery. The sealed bids should come to the Post office box with a dead line and must be marked SEALED BIDS.

New Business

Eric Reeves will cut the grass every two weeks for \$35.00. Councilman Jim Calvert will get in touch with him to make the arrangements. Councilman Larry Calvert made the motion, Councilman Bill Ivey seconded, the motion carried.

Councilman Larry Calvert made a motion to set a freeze on the erection of mobile homes with the exception of existing mobile home parks, subdivision parks and mobile homes. He wanted to hire attorney Charles Gorham to draw up an ordinance to prohibit all mobile homes and doublewides from being set up in the town. He wanted a freeze policy set up to exclude mobile homes and doublewides until such ordinance can be accepted by the town. Councilman Jim Calvert seconded the motion, Councilman Bill Ivey, Councilwomen Pam Sitton and Mellany Piper opposed and Councilmen Larry and Jim Calvert and Mayor Sue Calvert for it.

Councilwoman Mellany Piper made a motion to contact a lawyer and how the ordinance should be worded. Mayor Sue Calvert will contact the office of Gorham. Councilman Larry Calvert seconded, Councilman Bill Ivey opposed, the motion carried.

Councilwoman Pam Sitton made a motion to adjourn, Councilwoman Mellany Piper seconded, the meeting adjourned.
