

November 8, 2004

Roll was called by clerk, Marilee Calvert. Council members, Larry Calvert, Jim Calvert, Pam Sitton, Mellany Piper and Bill Ivey were not in attendance. Mayor Sue Blackmon stated that due to the failure to attend this meeting and previous October 11, 2004 meeting that Council Members had forfeited their council seats due to failure to attend for two consecutive meetings. Mayor Blackmon stated that the Council had voted this policy in as an ordinance in a prior meeting. She asked Marilee to find the meeting minutes that pertained to this ordinance. Mayor Blackmon appointed the following residents of County Line to the Council.

Malcolm Calvert to replace Jim Calvert
Jennifer Baldwin to replace Pam Sitton
Sandy Wells to replace Mellany Piper
Charles Cordar to replace Bill Ivey

Mayor Blackmon acknowledged that Commissioner Pitts was in attendance and asked him to address the 4 way stop sign issue. Commissioner Pitts read a letter from County Engineer Straggins stating that at the completion of the road work being done on County Line Road the 4 way stop would be put in place with rumble strips. Residents in attendance stated that they wanted the signs to be put up immediately before the completion of road work.

Mayor Blackmon addressed the issue of water line being extended for Mrs. Glover. The Mayor stated that in the original plans by the county in 1963 the line should have been run to the town limits. Therefore the county would be responsible for running the extension of the line.

The Mayor discussed obtaining grants for storm pit and tornado horn. Obtaining grants for other town projects was also discussed (i.e. walking track and paving of Town Hall parking lot). Cecil Calvert requested that when spending was necessary for the Town and improvement projects that the Council obtain bids to insure best price was obtained.

Mayor Blackmon requested that Marilee prepare a letter under her name to Commission Shelia Smoote and Commissioner Bettye Fine Collins asking what services they (county) provide for towns. Also ask about grant monies for public parks and walking tracks. Sue asked to Marilee to sign for her when letter was complete.
