

Town of County Line

Special called Town Council meeting September 30, 2010

Mayor Calvert called the meeting to order at 7:04PM Mayor Calvert asked Council Finch to open with prayer.

After prayer, Roll was called Present was Mayor J. L. Calvert, Councils Michael Calvert, Dennis Finch, Pam Sitton, Herman Mulvehill. Council Ralph Calvert was absent. A Quorum being present, meeting proceeded.

Mayor Calvert stated the purpose of this meeting was to discuss Constitutional Amendment No.2 on the November ballot and how it would adversely affect the Town of County Line and its future. Extensive discussion followed. Copies of a sample ballot was copied by the clerk and handed out to members of the Council and public audience. There was further discussion of what paths to pursue. Council Finch recommended to re-contact the Towns of Altoona and Garden City and Warrior as they are also in two counties including Blount County. Further discussion followed.

It was agreed that Mayor Calvert would contact Attorneys Fuller and Copeland the next day and discuss our possible courses of action and also re-contact the Towns of Altoona and Garden City and Warrior to see if they would possibly join County Line in this possible legal action. Council Finch moved to contact Attorney and get an opinion on how to proceed. Council Sitton seconded, Motion passed unanimously. The mayor advised he will also try to contact Senator Beason again.

Council Finch advised that he will probably be out of town for about 2 weeks.

Council Finch moved to adjourn, motion carried.
