Minutes of Regular scheduled Council Meeting February 8, 2011

Meeting was called to order at 7:09PM by Mayor J. L. Calvert

Roll was called with Mayor Calvert present, and Council members: Dennis Finch, Pam Sitton, and Herman Mulvehill present. Council Ralph Calvert was absent. A Quorum being present, meeting proceeded.

Minutes of January 18, 2011 were read. Council Pam Sitton moved to accept minutes with corrections., Council Mulvehill seconded, Motion carried unanimously

Communications: Clerk read an invoice from Attorney Thomas Prickett for publication of last annexation and legal notices, amount being \$1,015.50. Council Sitton moved to pay this invoice. Council Finch seconded, motion carried unanimously. Also received from Mr. Malcolm Calvert, a request from Ms. Sue F. Calvert for copies of last 6 meetings and had attached to it, a petition for de-Annexation from various people in and out of Town of County Line. The request for minutes had been recorded at the Probate Judge's office at Blount County.

There were no reports of committees. There were no resolutions to consider. There were no reports of Officers.

The Mayor discussed the condition of the Town Hall Roof and its current leaking condition. One Contractor advised \$4,400.00. The Mayor advised he had found someone that could do a temporary repair or patch job for \$600.00 until better weather.
