

**TOWN OF COUNTY LINE**  
**REGULAR MEETING**

**MAY 8th, 2017**

**I. Call to order**

Mayor Arthur Self called to order the regular meeting of the Council at 7:00 pm on May 8<sup>th</sup>, 2017 in the Town Hall. The invocation was given by Mr. Don Hagel.

**II. Roll call**

The roll call was had. The following persons were present: Mayor Arthur Self, councilor's Myrtle Van Kleeck, Eugene Kiley, and Brenda Lowe . Councilors Floyd Philpot and Steve Brewer were absent.

The minutes from the April 10<sup>th</sup> meeting were read with corrections to be made on the second page 1<sup>st</sup> paragraph replace motion carried with one abstaining to read motion carried with the Mayor abstaining the same paragraph change Scott made a motion to read Steve Brewer made a motion to pay seconded by Floyd Philpot.

A motion was made by Brenda Lowe to accept the minutes as read with corrections and seconded by Eugene Kiley, motion carried.

**III. OPEN ISSUES**

The new street sign and no parking signs have not been received from Blount County. A new contract between the town and county must be executed before signs will be made available

**IV. New Business**

The mayor requested from the Council the authorization to obtain estimates for lawn service to cut the grass around town hall and the park. A rough guess will be at least \$200 each time the grass is cut . Will request at least three estimates and go with the best price.

Word has been received that the sheriff deputies from Jefferson County that patrol the county line area would be out here more often if there was somewhere for them to use the restroom. The mayor will have additional keys made to town hall to be made available for the Jefferson County Sheriff deputies use. This is a small price to pay for the additional deputies in the area.
