

**TOWN OF COUNTY LINE**  
**REGULAR MEETING**

**December 11, 2017**

**I. Call to order**

Mayor Arthur Self called to order the regular meeting of the Council at 7:00 pm on December 11, 2017 in the Town Hall. The invocation was given by Myrtle VanKleleck. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all.

**II. Roll call**

The roll call was had. The following persons were present: Mayor Arthur Self, councilor's Myrtle Van Kleleck, Eugene Kiley, John King, and Steve Brewer. Brenda Lowe was absent.

**III. Approval of minutes and financials from last meeting**

The minutes of November 13<sup>th</sup>, 2017 were read, a motion was made by Steve Brewer to approve and seconded by Eugene Kiley to approve. Motion carried.

The financial reports were given , a motion to approve was made by Myrtle VanKleleck and seconded by John King. Motion carried.

**OPEN ISSUES**

Mayor Self reminded us that the Children's Christmas party was to be held on December 23, 2017. This party was to be coordinated by Sue Francis Calvert. A motion was made by Steve Brewer to give \$300 to buy food for feeding the Children. This motion was seconded by Myrtle and motion carried.

The matter of electing Dallas-Selville Fire Department to serve as the primary fire and rescue service for the Town of County Line, was discussed. The Mayor has received the address lists from Blount and Jefferson Counties. He will start verifying these in the coming weeks.

**IV. New Business**

Mayor Self suggested that the January Town Council Meeting be moved to January 9<sup>th</sup>, 2018, due to the possibility of the University of Alabama being in the College Championship game on January 8<sup>th</sup>. Steve made the motion to change the meeting date to January 9<sup>th</sup>, and John seconded. Motion was carried.
