Regular Meeting
December 9, 2019

Call to order

Mayor Arthur Self called to order the regular meeting of the Council at 7:00 pm on December 9, 2019 in the Town Hall. The invocation was given by Myrtle VanKleeck. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all.

I. Roll call

The roll call was had. The following persons were present: Mayor Arthur Self, councilor's Myrtle Van Kleeck, Eugene Kiley, Brenda Lowe, John King and Steve Brewer.

II. Approval of Minutes and Financials

The Minutes from the November regular meeting were read. Brenda Lowe made the motion to accept them with corrections. Seconded by Eugene Kiley. Motion carried.

The Financials for November were given. Steve Brewer made the motion to accept them as given. John King seconded. Motion carried.

III. Old Business

1. Steve Brewer reported in November that these lights were out: # 65 & # 13 on County Line Rd. # 30 & # 54 on Smith Mill Rd. #45 on Cobb Brazeel Rd The Clerk contacted APCO. Steve noted that he will check the lights again.

2. Mayor Self reported on our FEMA grant application for the Safe Room/Multipurpose Bldg. has been submitted to the Alabama Emergency

Management Authority for review and will be reviewed by FEMA later this month.

3. Mayor Self noted that County Line and Blount County had been added to the ALAWEST vs. Mulvehill, because they were in the lawsuit to close Reid Road. Update on this issue is that our lawyer will file a motion with the court to dismiss the Town of County Line from this lawsuit.

4. The Donation to Dallas-Selville Volunteer Fire Dept. was delivered on Monday, December 2, 2019 at their regular meeting.

New Business

1. Mayor Self shared news on a lawsuit about the Rebuild Alabama Act. This lawsuit delays the distribution of funds when collected.
2. Blount County District 4 Commissioner Nick Washburn spoke to us noting that he was running for re-election. He also took questions from everyone and explained his journey to this point.
3. Commissioner Washburn also asked the Town for a map with town limits marked on each street. He wanted to make sure that he is taking care of all that he should.
4. Candidate for Blount County Commissioner District 4, Daniel Gilliland spoke to us. He shared his qualification and answered questions for everyone.
5. Mayor and Council agreed to delay our regular meeting date for January 2020, for one day! It was re-scheduled for January 14, 2020.
6. Mayor Self read an Ordinance to adopt the Blount County Subdivision Regulations. Steve Brewer made a motion to consider this ordinance on the first reading. Eugene seconded. Motion was unanimous. Steve Brewer made a motion to accept it as read. Brenda Lowe seconded. Motion was unanimous.
