Regular Meeting
June 8, 2020

I. Call to order

Mayor Arthur Self called to order the regular meeting of the Council at 7:00 pm on June 8, 2020 in the Town Hall. The invocation was given by Myrtle VanKleeck. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all.

II. Roll call

The roll call was had. The following persons were present: Mayor Arthur Self, councilor's Myrtle Van Kleeck, Eugene Kiley, John King and Steve Brewer. Brenda Lowe was absent.

III. Approval of Minutes and Financials

The Minutes from the May regular meeting were read. Eugene Kiley made the motion to accept them as read. Seconded by Steve Brewer. Motion was unanimous.

IV. Old Business

1. There is no change on Cobb Brazeel Road potholes. It also needs some mow/trim work.

2. Update on FEMA grant application: We have an email from Mr. Lehe. The Town application was not selected for this grant cycle. We can't reapply this year. We will make a few changes and re-apply when other funds are available. The Mayor and Mr. Lehe will keep trying.
3. The update on ALAWEST vs. Mulvehill Lawsuit: Judge King has re-scheduled the hearing on the motion to dismiss County Line from the lawsuit for July 1, 2020 at the Blount County Courthouse. Mayor Self plans to be there.
4. We are waiting on the Clerk to get a quote for a parking lot perimeter fence.
5. The Clerk's office printer failed and was replaced at a cost of \$381.43 at Best Buy. The printer package included one laser printer/scanner/copier/fax along with two toner cartridges which should last for about 7500 printed pages.

New Business

1. Steve Brewer reported that all the streetlights as of May 31st, were on. Pole #60 on County Line Drive has it's dome hanging by the wiring only.
2. He also asked for someone to check all the streets for need of mow/trim. Blount and Jefferson County will be contacted to do the mow/trim work.
3. There was discussion on the upcoming election requirements. Mayor Self referred to the Election Manual for the information and dates.
